## REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF DRAFT TARIFFS FOR THE 2026/2027 FINANCIAL YEAR

Notice should be given in terms of the provisions of the Local Government Municipal Finance Management Act 56/2003 as well as Chapter 4 of the Local Government Municipal Systems Act 32/2000, that the Modimolle-Mookgophong Local Municipality In relation to the 2023/24 budget year, the municipal council also has to determine the municipal assessment rates to be charged on property i.t.o. section 17 of the Local Government Municipal Finance Management Act 56/2003. **Draft Tariffs for municipal services and assessment rates contained in this notice should be effective from 1st July 2026.**
